UK Energy prices followed the Oil Market which fell after an OPEC meeting which broke up after failing to agree on production cuts to stem the global glut of oil. Temperatures in the UK also remained above seasonal normal levels until a cold spell over the last few days leaving plenty of supply to cover any shortfall.

General Comments


Gas prices continued to be weighed down as winter continued with all eyes on the supply and demand balance which remained healthy even with some cuts in supply from the Norwegian and UK sectors of the North Sea. A short cut in withdrawal levels at the Rough storage facility failed to stimulate any interest in the market.

With the largest proportion of UK electricity generated by gas fired power stations, wholesale electricity prices mirrored the gas market and ended the month lower on a lack of winter weather.


Oil prices fell rapidly after an OPEC meeting at the beginning of December failed to agree on a production cut which could have bolstered prices.

With the rise in tensions between Saudi Arabia and Iran at the very end of December and into the first few days of January, in the past this would have seen oil prices rise however with the lifting of sanctions on Iran this was seen to be adding oil supplies to an already saturated market.


Electricity Annual Forward Baseload Price (Flat Cost)
